







MAHATMA GANDHI'S VISION



“Sanitation is more important than independence.”

– Mahatma Gandhi Ji

He made cleanliness and sanitation an integral part of the Gandhian way of living. His mission was total sanitation for all.

Swachh Bharat: Swachh Vidyalaya is the national campaign driving ‘Clean India: Clean Schools’. A key feature of the campaign is to ensure that every school in India has a set of functioning and well maintained water, sanitation and hygiene facilities. Water, sanitation and hygiene in schools refers to a combination of technical and human development components that are necessary to produce a healthy school environment and to develop or support appropriate health and hygiene behaviors. The technical components include drinking water, hand washing, toilet and soap facilities in the school compound for use by children and teachers. The human development components are the activities that promote conditions within the school and the practices of children that help to prevent water, hygiene and sanitation related diseases.

CLEANLINESS INITIATIVE

The school took up the community cleanliness activities to maintain good sanitation on the eve of Gandhi Jayanti, to promote Swacch Bharat Mission.

Following activities were done by the principal, teachers, few children and parents inside the school premises:

- Cleaning of classrooms, laboratories, library, etc.
- Cleaning of toilets and drinking water areas.
- Cleaning of playground. Clearing litters.
- Cleaning and maintenance of school garden.
- Plantation of saplings in school compound.

All of the above encouraged a spirit of cleanliness and ensure good civic sense.

This helped in inculcating the values among teachers, students and parents for cleaning their workplace, premises and surrounding environs. All of them joined hands to launch cleanliness drive to mark Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary with great fervor and enthusiasm.
